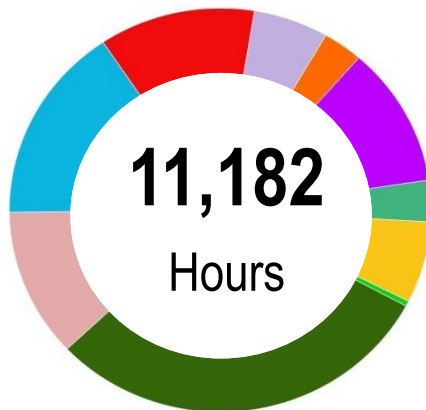

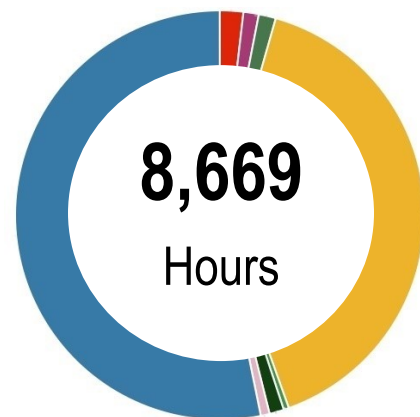

Dear Center Pointe Family,

On behalf of the Church Board and the Finance Team, I am honored to bring this financial report for the 2019-2020 church year. Our desire as a part of the financial leadership team at Center Pointe is to become more like Christ through faithfulness and transparency in the finances of the Church.

As a body, and through the various ministries of the Church, together we raised approximately \$1.6 million dollars. Our expenses were slightly less than our income and we had an emergency reserve at year-end of just over \$64,000.

Center Pointe was 100% faithful to pay all our local and general church budgets in full, including more than \$38,000 to the World Evangelism Fund to change lives and transform hearts all around the world in the name of Jesus! Because of your generosity to the 2019 Christmas fund, over \$33,000 was raised for Worship Center updates and to support the great commission work locally through Parents Night Out and globally through the Center for Missionary Formation in the Dominican Republic. Praise God!

Finally, your Church Board continued to pursue the potential sale of a part of our unused property to help pay down the \$2.7 million debt. Then God showed up in a BIG way - we were informed that our mortgage debt was PAID IN FULL and that WE ARE DEBT FREE! With this new freedom, we are now prayerfully seeking how God would have us move forward financially to advance His kingdom.

God is so good! Thank you for partnering with Him through the local body of Center Pointe Community Church of the Nazarene. Please continue to pray for God's miraculous provision and wisdom on our part as stewards of the resources He entrusts to us!
