## New This Year

Parents, we are all aware that this year has been very different from years past. As a council we have done our best to still offer camp with some precautions so that we can keep kids as safe as possible. Camp will have a very relaxed schedule and the groups will have a lot of choice in what they will do while at camp. We do not want there to be any pressure to attend camp. ## **Camp Rates**

There is one flat rate for camp this year - \$200 per camper. **But wait, the District is giving ALL campers a \$25 discount so camp will cost \$175!** Due to safety precautions, limited space is available. A \$50 deposit is due May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2021. After that, we will only accept additional registrations if space is available.

**The Jim Cummins Memorial Celebration Scholarship Fund is providing a \$75 scholarship for each camper off the price above!** PLEASE do not let finances stop your child from attending camp. If you need additional support, please let [Mrs. Ginger](#) know by Sunday, May 9<sup>th</sup>.

Payments are non-refundable but can be transferred to another camper or adult.

## **Registration Process**

Step 1: Register online at <https://forms.gle/4ggSJYBm3Wfxq6EN8>

Step 2: Print and complete Notarized Medical Form (Ms. Carolyn is a notary)

Step 3: Give notarized form and \$50 non-refundable deposit to Ms. Ginger by May 9<sup>th</sup>.

Step 4: Balance of camp fees due to Ms. Ginger by May 26<sup>th</sup>, 2021

**Please DO NOT mail money or forms to the District Office or campground.** All camp payments come from your church's camp coordinator together.

## **Medication and Lice Checks**

All medication will be turned in to the camp nurse upon arrival.

**All medications should be placed in a clear plastic bag in the original packaging and include the following: first & last name, church name and instructions.**

Over the counter medications are available through the nurse. There is no need to send these.

Lice checks will be done at the campers arrival to camp. Campers who have lice will not be able to stay at the campground. They will be able to return to camp 24 hours after treatment. Camp leadership will not be able to treat campers. Please check your campers for lice the week prior to camp! **No refunds will be given in the case of lice.**
