Dear Center Pointe Family,

Please accept this letter as the financial report for our Fiscal Year (March 1, 2021 – February 28, 2022).

As we close out this year, we are celebrating God's goodness and the blessings poured out upon Center Pointe. As we continue to navigate our new post-pandemic normal, we continue to seek His wisdom.

Here are some highlights (numbers are rounded):

- \$1.38 million—2021/2022 Center Pointe budget
- \$701,000—The amount our faithful givers returned to God in the form of Tithes & Offerings, Faith Promise, and The Christmas Offering.
- \$171,000—The amount forgiven of our Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) loan...that's 100%!
- \$564,000—The income from our Journey Preschool even through the rigors of the pandemic.
- \$59,500—Grant money awarded to Journey Early Learning Center for playground and equipment upgrades.
- \$15,200—The balance in the Jim Cummins Memorial Scholarship Fund that provides scholarships for children, teens, and college students to participate in life-changing opportunities.
- \$33,872—Center Pointe's contribution to the World Evangelism Fund.
- \$15,000—Our Emergency Fund balance.
- \$0—The total amount of outstanding bills. Praise the LORD!

As can be seen, God is SO GOOD! We are debt-free and up-to-date on all financial obligations. We look forward to God's direction this year and thank you for partnering with Him through Center Pointe.
